- 2. Students are expected to master the Michigan Civics Content Expectations
- 3. iPads:
 - -flat on desk when in use; NO GAMES, NO SOCIAL MEDIA
 - -under your desk when not in use
 - -ABSOLUTELY no pictures / video without permission from the teacher
 - -iPads are to be charged before class NOT DURING CLASS

Chronic failure to comply may lead to loss of iPad privileges, loss of APP Store, detention, and/or parent/guardian meeting

- 4. Cell Phones:
 - -placed in the holder on the classroom door OR in your locker
 - -used ONLY with permission from the teacher

Chronic failure to do so may result in cell phone going to the office, detention, and/or parent/guardian meeting

 - -students will have a seating chart and will sit in their assigned seat
 - -alternative seating must have permission from the teacher
 - -couch is OFF LIMITS unless permission is given by the teacher
